The C. V. Raman College of Engineering, Bhubaneswar is a reputed autonomous college affiliated to the Biju Patnaik University of Technology (BPUT). While the college is already well known for its excellent undergraduate and postgraduate programmes in engineering, science and management, it has now formally started an ambitious Ph D programme in all disciplines in accordance the guidelines of UGC for autonomous colleges.

Application are now invited from eligible candidates for admission to the Ph.D. programme of the college in the following disciplines:

Engineering:

Electrical engineering, Electronic & communication engineering, Instrumentation engineering, Computer science and Information Technology, Mechanical engineering, Chemical engineering, Civil engineering and Marine engineering.

Science:

Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics

Humanity & Social science:

English, Economics

Management:

Finance, HR, Marketing

For applicable regulations, candidate are advised to visit the college website: www.cvrce.edu.in. The college is shall provide the appropriate scholastic environment for carrying out research at a level appropriate to institutions of higher learning of our country. It is working towards creating superior computational and experimental facilities to support the doctoral programmes.

Eligibility:

B. Tech./M.Sc./ M.Tech./ M. Pharm./ M.A./ MBA as relevant to the discipline of interest with academic score as listed in the regulations.

Financial support:

A limited number of fellowships and assistantships are available for candidates with superior academic record. The fellowship, depending on the award, shall cover the whole or a part of the tuition fee payable to the college.If interested, candidates are advised to apply for fellowship on plain paper enclosing complete bio-data and career plans. The quantum of financial support will depend on the merit of the student and the branch of study.

Fees:

The normal tuition fee of the Ph D programme is equal to the post-graduate tuition fee in the respective subject. Students may, however, apply for the college fellowships or assistantship to offset the cost of tuition. In addition to tuition fee, a student needs to pay admission fee, thesis evaluation fee, other studentship fees and fee charged by BPUT.

Sponsored Candidates:

Candidates employed in academic or R&D organisations, Government, NGOs or Industry may be sponsored by their respective employers for pursuing Ph.D. on topics important to them. Such applications must contain a sponsorship letter from the employer. Sponsored candidates will receive preference in admission and, wherever applicable, permission to carry out research work in their respective places of employment. There are special provisions for candidates employed in the commuting distance from the college and for employees of institutions collaborating with CVRCE in research. Candidates may consult the regulations for details.

Faculty of CVRCE

In order to maintain a strong scholastic climate on campus and ensure quality education, CVRCE mandates that every member of the faculty is engaged in research, either by guiding Ph.D. student or by pursuing Ph.D. under guidance of senior faculty. Members of CVRCE faculty shall normally be exempt from tuition fees, but shall pay other fees of the college. No separate administrative clearance is necessary.

Selection Process:

Candidates desirous of pursuing Ph D in CVRCE may apply for admission to the Ph.D. programme at any time of the year. They are encouraged to discuss their research interests and other academic/administrative issues with potential guides, Heads of the Departments, Dean (Academic) and Principal. Applications accumulated over time will be screened by the Research Programme Implementation Committee from time to time. All application received before the meeting date will be screened for suitability by evaluation of information contained in the applications, written exam followed by Interview, as mandated by regulation of the UGC. The selection committee will evaluate not only the merit of the candidates but also their research interests, facilities available at CVRCE including those that can be created in short run, and viability of the research programme considering the candidates' other commitments.

Closing Date of application:

The earliest date for such scrutiny shall be 29 October 2018. Applications received after that date will be considered in the next meeting of the RPIC.
